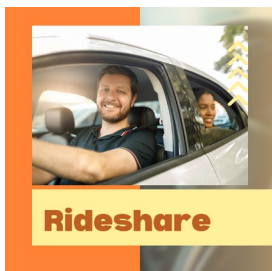
## ***VoiceOver 101***

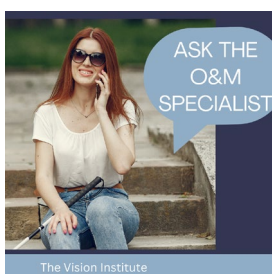
## ***Rideshare for O&M***

**Low Vision Accessibility for iOS Devices**
